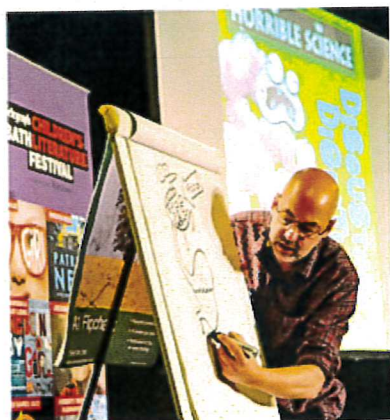


### Superhero Tables' Challenge

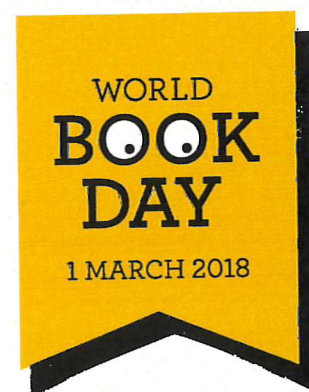


There will be an opportunity to purchase his books alongside all of the children being given their World Book Day token. Information about the free books can be found on the World Book Day website
