Toys

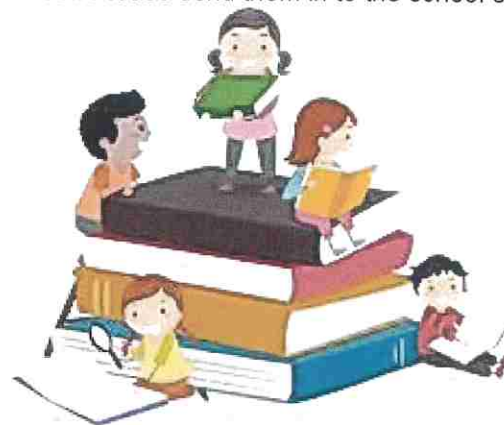
We have noticed a number of children bringing 'fiddle toys' to school. We would like to remind parents and children that 'toys' should **not** be brought into school.

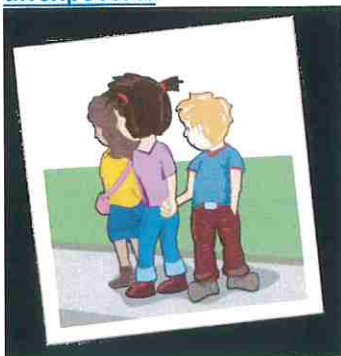
Road safety
