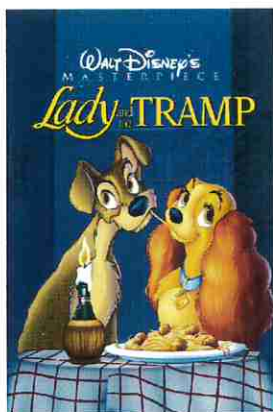
PANCAKE RACE
