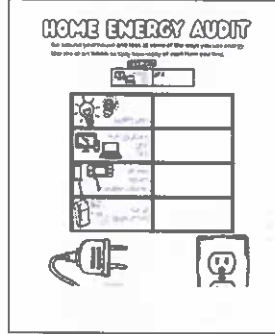




Easter 2026 Project Homework

Don't forget to put your name and class on your work. Possible ideas include:

- My Eco-Friendly Week Diary e.g., turning off lights, recycling, walking instead of driving.
- A PowerPoint presentation about sustainability
- A Where Does My Rubbish Go? Poster
- Upcycled Art Project (bottles, cardboard, paper, tin cans) to create a model, sculpture or useful item e.g. pencil holder from a can
- A Plant-Growing Challenge- grow something from kitchen scraps or seeds.
- An Energy Detectives Home Audit Investigate where energy is used in the home (lights, devices, heating).
- Food Miles Investigation -Choose 5–10 foods from the cupboard or fridge and find out where they came from.
 - Sustainable fashion – redesign an old T-shirt into something new e.g. bag, pillowcase
 - Make a Simple Solar Oven using a pizza box, foil, cling film, and black card
